Next, showed

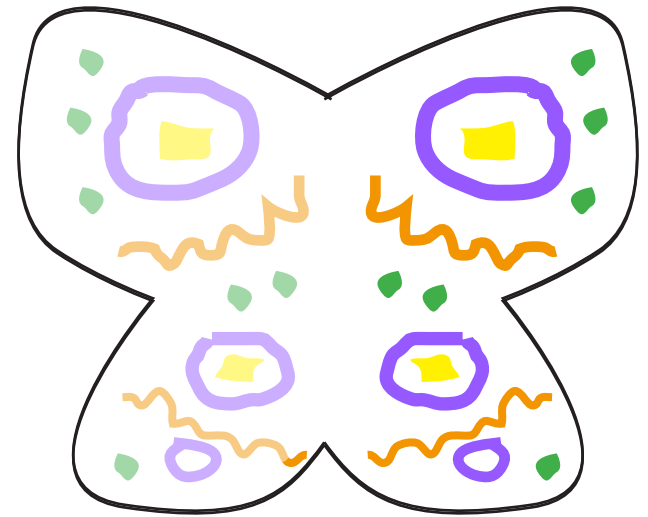
how to fold the paper.

1. Put one tablespoon of cornstarch in a one quart microwavable bowl.
2. Add one tablespoon of cold water. Stir well.
3. Add two-thirds cup of cold water. Stir well.
4. Microwave for thirty seconds. Stir.
5. Microwave for thirty more seconds. Stir.
6. Microwave for thirty MORE seconds. Stir.
7. If mixture is not thickened and slightly bubbly, microwave for thirty more seconds. Stir.
8. Allow to cool.

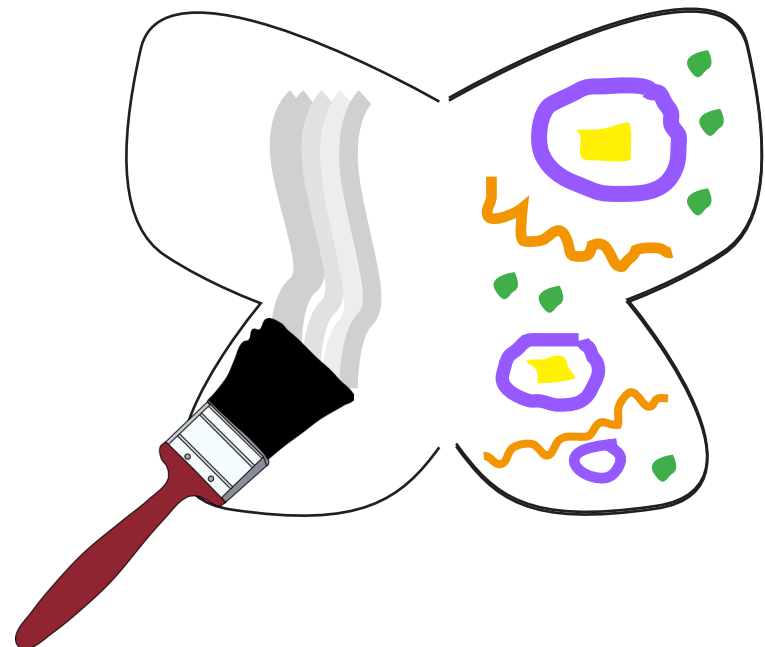


While the duplicating gel cooled,

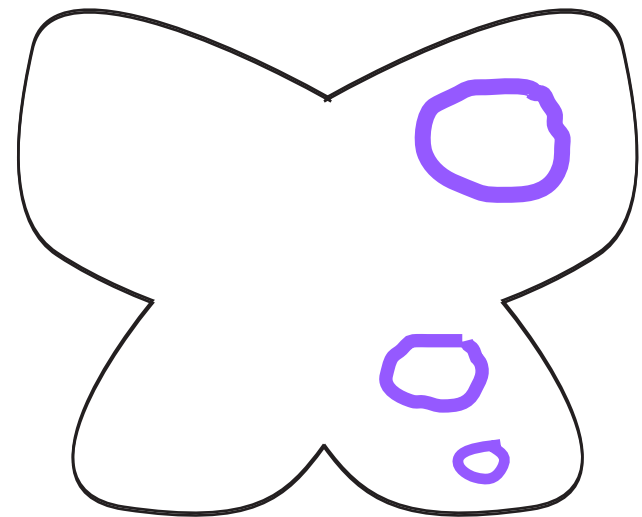

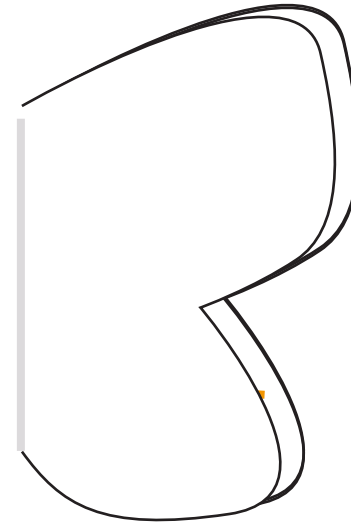
used a paintbrush to brush magic
